

HELPING OUTSTANDING PUPILS IN EDUCATION

HOPE an initiative aimed at identifying the academically brilliant but financially challenged students from 8th grade across the villages of Kerala, to support them to complete their higher secondary education and beyond successfully, and hence mature into responsible professionals in their chosen fields. HOPE, spread over all the 14 districts of Kerala and plans to extend HOPE scholarship to 1000 students in the near future.

HOPE PLUS launched in 2017 is the logical extension of HOPE to support HOPE beneficiaries for higher education. Under this scheme, HOPE beneficiaries who complete their 12th grade with outstanding academic performance will be supported for 5 more years to pursue the higher education in their chosen areas of interest. The most eligible students will be provided financial support (INR 20,000 to INR 60,000 per year) for a maximum period of 5 years.

Key Features

- Provides scholarship support, mentoring and professional guidance
- Conducts empowerment workshops and focused training sessions
- Personalized mentoring program for each student

HOPE CARES is a comprehensive programme covering the most backward rural and tribal areas of Kerala with a multipronged approach to financial support, mentoring, hand-holding through higher education and employment support through skill development.

Key Features


- Create awareness among students in tribal/rural areas on the need to pursue higher education.
- Provide scholarship support for the most deserving students.
- Train the teachers to motivate students.
- Create awareness among parents.

PROGRAMME is aimed at extending job oriented training to school dropouts from the tribal belt. The objective of the programme is to help them find a livelihood by acquiring proficiency in specialised areas. The programme is being operational in Attappadi (Palakkad District) and Wayanad.
