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
Report on HOPE Activities

Statistics on HOPE Scholars and Disbursement of Scholarships

During the last academic year [2015-'16], HOPE has disbursed Rs 21 Lakhs as HOPE Excellence Awards to 309 No. of outstanding children from 180 Govt./Govt. aided schools from all the 14 districts, which covers the entire Kerala.


