

**2011** started with 30 students from Grade 8


**2015** reached all 14 districts of Kerala

## STATE LEVEL HOPE EMPOWERMENT CAMP 2016 @ KOCHI

State level camp for all HOPE beneficiaries of Kerala was held at Renewal Centre, Kochi from 13 to 15 Aug 2016.

Eminent personalities like Mr. Haneesh Mohammed IAS, Prof. M.K Sanu, Mr. Rishi Raj Singh IPS, Mr. Alphonse Kannanthanam IAS, Dr. M. Chandra Dathan (Former VSSC Director), Dr. Letha Raj, Mr. John P.V interacted with the students during the 3 days session.

Training programmes on various topics such as Personality Development, Career Guidance, Arts and Crafts, Exhibition and Project Demos, Moral & Psychological support to Teenagers, IT & Communication skills were conducted by professional trainers. Some of the major attractions of the camp were dedicated sessions for parents and cultural programmes by HOPE scholars.

# HOPE CARES

COMPREHENSIVE APPROACH FOR RURAL EDUCATION SUPPORT



## OBJECTIVES

- **Create awareness among students in tribal/rural areas on the need to pursue higher education**
- **Provide scholarship support for the most deserving students**
- **Train the teachers to motivate students**
- **Create awareness among parents**

**HOPE CARES** is a comprehensive programme covering the most backward rural and tribal areas of Kerala with a multipronged approach to financial support, mentoring, hand-holding through higher education and employment support through skill development.

# HOPE CARES

HOPE CARES was formally launched at Govt. High School, Agali, Attappadi on 01 October 2016. A total of **180 students** studying in grade 8 were selected from three Govt. tribal schools (Agali, Sholayur, and Puthur). Three training programmes were conducted during the academic year 2016-17 (1 Oct 2016, 28 Jan 2017 and 22 July 2017) at Govt. Higher Secondary School, Agali, Attappadi. HOPE CARES scholarships were distributed to 40 selected students.

Three training sessions are planned at Attappadi during the academic year 2017-18.



# **VOLTAS HOPE CARES VOLTAS**

## **Skill Development Programme**

**HOPE CARES** Skill development programme is aimed at extending job oriented training to school drop outs from the tribal belt. The objective of the programme is to help them find a livelihood by acquiring proficiency in specialized areas. We have started this programme from Attappadi, Palakkad District and will be spreading the same to other tribal areas. The first batch of 30 candidates, who couldn't pursue their higher studies, selected from Attappadi area were sent for an intensive skill development program in **ICICI skill development center in Coimbatore**. This is being organised in association with **Voltas Ltd**. The center provides training in areas like Refrigeration & Air Conditioning, Two and Three-wheeler servicing, Pumps and Motors repairs, etc.

**22 candidates who successfully completed this training programme were provided employment in different companies in South India.** Training for the next batch is scheduled to start at Coimbatore in September 2017.



# VOLTAS HOPE PLUS VOLTAS

HOPE PLUS, launched this year is the logical extension of HOPE to support HOPE beneficiaries for higher education. Under this new scheme, HOPE beneficiaries who complete their 12th grade with outstanding academic performance will be supported for 5 more years to pursue the higher education in their chosen areas of interest. This project is being fully funded and supported by **Voltas Ltd** through their CSR initiatives.

The most eligible students will be provided financial support (INR 20,000 to INR 60,000 per year) for a maximum period of 5 years. For the year 2017 **50 students** were awarded HOPE PLUS scholarships.

Shri P Vijayan IPS (Inspector General of Police, Kochi Range) inaugurated the Central zone camp and launched HOPE PLUS project for the central districts.


