1. Introduction

It is my privilege to present the Annual Report of CETA GALAXY Charitable Trust (CGCT) 2019-20 for your consideration and approval.

We take this opportunity to thank all our trustees and well-wishers for their support and active involvement in our activities. Our special thanks to Mr. Joseph Charles and Soorya Charles for providing us the office at Trivandrum.

Honorable Mr. E. Harry left us on 26th August'20 and we express our deepest condolences to the family and place on record the support, services and guidance extended by him to CGCT. We also place on record our deep gratitude and appreciation towards our senior member Mr. P.K. Ashokan for his leadership. We are very much grateful to all our trustees, volunteers, well-wishers and sponsors for their support.

The 7th Annual General Body Meeting of CETA GALAXY Charitable Trust was held on 17.08.19 at Mustard Restaurant, Garhoud.

The meeting started at 7.25pm with Silent Prayer. Hon. Chairman Mr. P.K. Ashokan presided over the meeting. The secretary read out the notice of the AGM and its agenda. Mr. Joseph Charles welcomed the members to the AGM.

In his presidential address, the Hon. Chairman, Mr. P.K. Ashokan stated that all our volunteers are working in close coordination towards our social commitment and all our volunteers enjoy working for a cause like this. Our activities helped our volunteers to learn a lot and gives us immense pleasure and satisfaction.

The Hon. Secretary Mr. Satheesh Kumar presented the annual report for the year 2018-19, audited financial statements for the year 2018-19 and a note on the current and future activities as annex A to the report. Secretary highlighted the achievements of our 10th and 12th grade students. Two of our HOPE Plus beneficiaries from Wayanad district completed their graduation with 1st rank from Kannur University.

Our software is almost ready and the HOPE and HOPE Plus applications for 2019-20 are processed through our newly developed data management platform.

The Moncompu school project-awaiting design approval from the Executive Engineer, district panchayath, Alappuzha. Tender documents are ready, and we hope to start the construction soon.

The Hon. Treasurer Mr. Tenny Isaac explained the audited accounts and presented the annual budget for the year 2019-20. Mr. Tenny explained that last financial year ended with Rs 13lakhs deficit mainly due to the shortfall of sponsorship for HOPE Plus and the state camp. All our scholarship payments are online now except for the newly inducted students.

Treasurer highlighted the urgent need for increasing the sponsors and CSR partners. Camp expenses for 2019-20 is estimated at Rs 22 lakhs and we need more sponsorship for the camps.

AGM discussed the annual report, audited financial statements and the budget in detail and suggested the following minor amendments:

1. Last year deficit should reflect on the budget for 2019-20.
2. The school project should reflect in the income and expenditure statements.
3. Revathy fund Rs20,000/-can be transferred to meet the camp expenses.

Mr. Biju RS proposed, and Mr. A.R. Suresh Kumar seconded, and the meeting unanimously approved the report, audited financial statements and the budget with the above amendments.

The AGM decided to appoint M/s SATHIAVAGEESWARAN. S & Co, Trivandrum as the Auditor for 2019-20 and Mr. Thomas Kurian as the internal auditor.

Under the agenda- future activities, the AGM discussed the following,

- a) We should see how we can spread the camp expenses to our HOPE sponsors by requesting some additional amount for each student.
- b) The skill development programme to be re-moulded in such a way making it beneficial to our HOPE and HOPE Plus students.
- c) We should initiate an empowerment programme for CET students with industrial association.
- d) Since many CSR companies are reluctant to pay for education scholarship, we have to brainstorm on how we can re-design the HOPE Plus programme more effectively to get proper value addition to students.
- e) The proposal for setting up a digital learning center is under consideration. AAI, Calicut offered CSR support for the same.
- f) HOPE renewal process should be more stringent to ensure academic quality.
- g) It was decided to revise the scholarship amount for HOPE Plus Engineering. Students

as Rs 40,000/- for hostellers and Rs 20,000/- for day scholars.

- h) HOPE New intake for 2019-20- 144 students short listed already and the number may go up to 150.

Mr. Rudra Kumar expressed the vote of thanks and meeting adjourned at 9.15 pm.

2. HOPE - Helping Outstanding Pupils in Education

We are incredibly happy to record that during 2019-20 academic year we could support 553 students spread over 14 districts: 223 boys and 330 girls. We have awarded INR 34.65 lakhs as scholarship to our beneficiaries during 2019-20.

143 students completed their 10th grade and are promoted to class 11 this academic year and 72 students completed their 12th grade. Many of our 10th & 12th standard students scored A+ in all their subjects.

3.1 HOPE Activities

3.1.1 HOPE Volunteers Meeting

Meetings of HOPE volunteers were held in at Adoor and Palakkad in connection with the Zonal camps. Meeting at Adoor was held on 27 Aug'19 and HOPE Volunteers meeting at Palakkad was held on 30th Nov'19 at Lead College of Management. Meeting of HOPE Volunteers from Trissur district was held on 29.11.19 at GEC Trissur to plan the activities of Trissur district. Another meeting was held on 09.02.20 to form various clusters and assign volunteers for each cluster. A meeting of HOPE Plus students from Wayanad was conducted on 31.03.20 at Wayanad to discuss the mentoring programme for HOPE students. HOPE volunteers meeting at Calicut was held on

08.02.20 at GEC Kozhikode to plan the activities of the district. HOPE Kasaragod volunteers meeting was conducted on 02.02.20 at LBS College, Kasaragod. Meeting with HOPE students and teachers was held at different schools in Kannur on 11.10.19 and 13.11.19. Meeting of HOPE Plus students from Ernakulam was held on 12.10.19 at Engineers club, Kochi. HOPE volunteers from Trivandrum district met on 16.11.19 at CET.

3.1.2 HOPE South Zone Camp 2019

South Zone Camp was held in Mar Thoma Youth Centre, Adoor on 13, 14, 15 September 2019 for students from Thiruvananthapuram to Trissur districts. Separate training programmes for HOPE and HOPE Plus beneficiaries were conducted. More than 400 students and their parents (approx. 700 persons)

5 'Samagra'-Rebuilding of Flood affected School

CETA Galaxy Charitable Trust in association with M/s Alfa Laval India Private Limited, Pune initiated the rebuilding of flood affected Moncompu Avittam Thirunal Government Vocational Higher Secondary School, Kuttanad, Alappuzha. The 1st phase of the rebuilding activities, fully sponsored by M/s Alfa Laval India Private Limited was to construct 4nos classrooms, 6nos toilets for ladies and RO plant for the school at an estimated cost of Rs 89 lakhs. Though we engaged structural and architectural consultants for developing the design and drawings and submitted the same for the technical sanction, we could not get the approvals due to the soil conditions at site. As discussed with M/s Alfa Laval and Alappuzha district Panchayath, we have decided to drop the construction of new building and changed the scope as refurbishment of existing facilities. New MOU was signed, and the supply and commissioning of new computer lab was completed on 7thFeb'20. COVID19

Appendix A (Details of Current and Future Activities)

1. DETAILS OF CURRENT & FUTURE ACTIVITIES

1.1 Pandemic & HOPE.

The global situation has changed drastically due to the unprecedented spread of COVID 19 pandemic since Feb'20. This has affected the life of all sections of the society. Students were the worst affected as all schools and colleges are closed for the last many months. The academic and co-curricular activities are badly affected. This has resulted in lots of concern and stress among our HOPE beneficiaries and their families. During 2020 we may not be able to organize our

regional camps or district level workshops due to this situation. Considering the gravity of the problem, CGCT has planned lots of activities during this period to help our students and volunteers to overcome the crisis. Online classes and interactive sessions are being organized. Training programmes for different batches are being conducted in which eminent persons and professional trainers are interacting with the students.

1.2. Online Empowerment Sessions.

The following programmes are conducted using online platforms.

1. HOPE Plus-Session on C.V preparation and Presentation was conducted on 25.04.20. Mr. A. R. Suresh Kumar, Vice President and Head of International Business Group, Voltas Limited interacted with the students. This was followed by C.V preparation and presentation by students. Outstanding students were rewarded with cash awards. Mr. Biju R S and Priji. S sponsored the cash awards.

2. HOPE Plus-A session on "Introduction to banking and financial sector" was organized on 01.05.20. Mr. S S Jayasankar of CET 93 batch handled the session. This was useful for students who wish to peruse their career in the financial or banking sector.
3. HOPE Iftar gathering was organized on 16.05.20 and was attended by around 75 volunteers and their families. Abu. S did a presentation on the latest activities of HOPE and our plans for 2020-21.

4. HOPE Plus- Session on “Technology Adaptation” was organized on 26.06.20. Mr. Prem Kishore, Vice President of UST Global interacted with the students.
5. SSLC students- Orientation classes regarding plus 1 admission (for SSLC passed students) was conducted on 19.07.20. Mr. V K Krishna Kumar led this session which was useful for students to clear their doubts and concerns while selecting the stream of education in plus1.
6. Plus 2 students- Career guidance session for plus 2 students was conducted on 27.07.20. Mr. V. K. Krishna Kumar handled the session and was very much useful to the students seeking admission for undergraduate courses.
7. HOPE plus- An enlightening session on “Why Entrepreneurship” was organized on 04.08.20. Padma Bhushan Kris Gopalakrishnan, Co-founder of Infosys was the chief guest on this webinar. He answered lots of questions from our students and it was a great opportunity for our HOPE Plus beneficiaries.
8. HOPE Plus- Stress Management session. “The Pandemic and the Mind’ was organized on 08.08.20. Dr. Manju Peethambaran, Consultant Psychiatrist, Govt. of Kerala, interacted with the students on stress management during the pandemic situation.
9. Grade 11 students- “POWER WITHIN”-A series of interactive English communication session for plus 1 student was launched on 15.08.20. Mrs. Prabha Sunder, renowned English teacher interacted with the students. The 2nd session was conducted on 10.09.20. We are planning to conduct one session every month for the benefit of our grade X and XI students.

1.3 HOPE Volunteers Meetings.

Since physical meetings are practically not feasible during the COVID 19 situation, HOPE Volunteers meeting was organized using online platforms. Many such meetings are conducted in various districts. These meetings are organized to discuss, plan and monitor HOPE activities

across the state. District activities are further divided in to 3 or 4 clusters and cluster leaders are assigned to coordinate the activities.
