



Celebrating 10 Years





'Decennial' - the tenth anniversary celebration of CETA Galaxy Charitable Trust (CGCT) was held on was held on 29th July'21 through Zoom and Facebook Live. Shri. Biju R S, the trust's secretary, delivered the welcome address and gave an overview of all various charitable projects led by CGCT. He detailed the projects titled HOPE (Helping Outstanding Pupils in Education - for 633 students from grade 8 to 12 including 70 students from Attappadi), HOPE PLUS (for 127 student beneficiaries pursuing higher education), HOPE CARES (rural education programme focused on tribal areas - currently covering 3 schools in Attappadi), and HOPE Skill Development Programme. He also thanked all the CSR sponsors, volunteers, and well-wishers.

The Presidential Address was delivered by Satheesh Kumar, who gave a glimpse on the formation of the charitable trust and the thought behind it. According to Mr Satheesh Kumar, the CGCT was formed during the CETAA Global Meet, the global alumni gathering of all the CET alumni community, in UAE in 2011. Dr Babu Paul IAS distributed the first HOPE scholarship to Bipin Raj. The trust was formally announced in November, 2011 while distributing scholarships to 16

school students. The project was later expanded to Attappadi and the HOPE CARES was launched.

Avani Unni, a beneficiary of HOPE scholarship from Wayanad, and Anupriya from Attappadi who got A+ in all subjects shared their experiences. In his keynote address, Mohammed Hanish highlighted the importance of contributing back to the society, and these memories of CET can be cherished. Later, Jyothirmayi A K, another HOPE scholarship beneficiary sang an old melody from Malayalam to cheer the crowd. Various other beneficiaries shared their experiences and their ideas for attracting students into HOPE. A digitisation plan was also shared. The program concluded with the vote of thanks by Thrideep VS, another secretary of CGCT.

Virtual Camp - Wayanad District




On Independence Day, (Aug 15, 2021) we were able to conduct virtual camps in 4 districts


Talk on 'Living your dream' on 19th August 2021 HOPE Kottayam District

"The Glory of Success" - HOPE Kasargode District



HOPE Idukki Get-Together







HOPE Malappuram District








The HOPE Malappuram District virtual meet happened on 22nd Aug, 2021 at 04:30 pm.

The session saw active participation by beneficiaries from Kozhikode.






HOPE Kannur online meet-up was conducted on 29 Aug, 2021 at 4:00 pm via Zoom Meet.




English Communication Session

Meeting our Eldest Sponsor





HOPE PLUS

HOPE PLUS, launched in 2017 is the logical extension of HOPE to support HOPE beneficiaries for higher education. Under this scheme, HOPE beneficiaries who complete their 12th grade with outstanding academic performance will be supported for 5 more years to pursue higher education in their chosen areas of interest. The most eligible students will be provided financial support (INR 15,000 to INR 60,000 per year) for a maximum period of 5 years.

During the year 2021-22, 42 new students were awarded HOPE PLUS scholarships making the total number of HOPE Plus beneficiaries 183. Another major milestone under HOPE Plus project is extending the support for students from College of Engineering Trivandrum (CET). We are extremely proud to share that out of the total 183 students, 57 beneficiaries are from CET. We thank the management from College of Engineering Trivandrum for all the coordination effort in implementing this project.

HOPE plus students are being supported by M/s Voltas Ltd, M/s Saint Gobain India Pvt Ltd and M/s Orbinox Ltd. HOPE PLUS students are being active volunteers in CGCT activities and have taken a proactive role in organizing the district level camps and workshops as well as the South Zone & North Zone empowerment camps.

As part our activities we have planned more such sessions via online to help the students in the upcoming days.


HOPE Plus Meet - Cultural Fest

HOPE CARES

Skill Development Programme

HOPE CARES is a comprehensive programme covering the most backward rural and tribal areas of Kerala with a multipronged approach to financial support, mentoring, handholding through higher education, and employment support through skill development. Currently, 310 students from 3 tribal schools in the Attappady area of Palakkad district are being supported under this. HOPE CARES activities for 2019-20 were officially launched by Dr. Navneet Sharma IPS, ASP, Palakkad at Government Higher Secondary School, Agali on July 6, 2019. Scholarships for 20 new beneficiaries were also distributed. Over 300 students from Sholayur, Agali, and Pudur attended the day-long training session.









HOPE CARES Skill Development Programme is aimed at extending joboriented training to school dropouts from the tribal belt. The objective of the programme is to help them find a livelihood by acquiring proficiency in specialized areas. Selected students are being sent for intensive skill development training at the ICICI Skill Development Centre in Coimbatore. The programme is being organised in association with Voltas and is operational in Attappadi (Palakkad District) and Wayanad. Upon successful completion, around 310 youths from Attappadi and Wayanad have already been placed in various reputed companies in South India.
